August was the month dedicated to exploration of the concepts of 'defeat' and 'victory' by minors . Within this theme, targeted discussions were held with the beneficiaries regarding the ways of managing defeat and victory in their daily lives.





In addition, recreational activities were implemented in which, together with the staff of the structure, the children participated in different board games with the aim of cultivating important social skills, such as adapting to changing conditions, learning to deal with unexpected challenges and conflict management.

Children had the opportunity to resolve conflicts in a controlled environment. They could learn how to compromise, negotiate and find solutions to disputes, developing conflict resolution skills.

Winning a game helped boost a child's selfesteem and confidence, on the other hand, losing taught them resilience and the ability to handle disappointment.
